

Registration for **ALL** new students for the 2018-19 school year will be on <u>Thursday, March 1, 2018</u> at Point Road School. This year parents will be completing the registration form online using the following website: https://genesis.genesisedu.com/littlesilver/openReg. After you complete all of the screens online, you will be prompted to print your registration form.

Please bring this form to Point Road School according to the times listed below for your last name. It is not required that you bring your child with you to registration.

Last names A - K 9:00 AM - 11:00 AM Last names L - Z 1:00 PM - 2:30 PM

If you cannot come during your assigned session, please feel free to come to the other session that day.

The following requirements must be presented at registration.

- 1. Your printed registration from your online registration.
- 2. An **original birth certificate** or passport for proof of age MUST BE PRESENTED AT REGISTRATION. Board of Education Policy 5112 requires that a child must be 5 years of age on or before October 1st of the year a child enters kindergarten.
- 3. **2 Proofs of Residency** (acceptable proof: utility bill/receipt, tax bill/receipt, recent receipt or contract of sale/rent. If you are renting, you MUST produce a new rental contract vearly).
- 4. An **immunization record** for each child that you are registering. (Copies will be made and originals returned to you at time of registration.)

3-Year Old Half Day Pre-school Tuition-based Lottery Information: You must complete the necessary forms in paper; there is not an online registration process for the preschool lottery. You are asked to return all paper information on March 1, 2018. Pre-school tuition will be \$4,000/year (2 installments of \$2,000) for 2.5 hour AM 3-year old class. The 4-year old class is full. No lottery students will be accepted for the 4-year old program.
