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Dear Parents,

In August, I sent you a letter regarding Technology Insurance. I explained that with rising operational costs, there is little room for anything other than the necessities. This year, students in grades 1-8 have been assigned a Chromebook specifically to them. While we work hard to teach students to be responsible, we continue to deal with broken computer components. It has become cost prohibitive for the district to purchase insurance for every computer. It is also time prohibitive for a two-person Technology Department to attend to on-going repairs. Therefore, I encouraged parents to purchase an annual insurance policy for your child's assigned device at a cost of **\$20** for the 2017-18 school year. Parents are not required to purchase the insurance, but I respectfully ask that you reply one way or the other to ensure me that you are aware of this offer. Should you choose **not** to purchase an insurance policy and your child damages his/her device, the following will reflect the repair costs that will be imposed:

- LCD Screen w/Case - Fully Assembled - **\$120**
- Motherboard - **\$140**
- Keyboard/Touchpad - **\$55**
- Case Top - **\$50**
- Case Bottom - **\$30**
- LCD Screen Bezel (Trim) - **\$35**
- Power plug - **\$15**

If you have already responded to my initial Technology Insurance letter, you need not do anything. If, however, you have not responded, I would greatly appreciate it if you would complete the bottom of this form and return it to your child's School Office as soon as possible.
